Walter Bair. The Earth Sciences major who attends Shippensburg State University in Pennsylvania figured in a landmark free speech case in federal court. The court ruled that Shippensburg had to revise the speech codes which forbid patriotic displays in the wake of the September 11, 2001 attacks on the United States.

M. Stanton Evans. The legendary author and journalist discusses his forthcoming book on the controversy surrounding the late Senator Joseph McCarthy, R-WI, who investigated communist penetration of the U. S. government in the 1950s. Evans researched the original government files on the suspects McCarthy investigated and found their guilt more apparent than college professors lead their students to believe it was.
